



Victory Kids Health Policy (Nursery)

To ensure the health and safety of all the children and staff at Victory, we ask that no child with the following symptoms be dropped off at Victory Kids.

Please follow these guidelines and if your child has any of these symptoms, please keep him/her home.

- **Fever** within the last 24 hours (100°F underarm; 101°F oral).
- **Vomiting** (twice or more in 24 hours).
- **Diarrhea**, three runny stools in a row.
- **Excessive wheezing or coughing** (child gets red or blue in the face and makes a high-pitched whoop after cough).
- **First 2 days of a cold**, especially if the child is uncomfortable or has a runny nose with yellow/green mucous or a persistent cough.
- **Sore throat with fever and swollen glands. Rash** (not heat or allergy related).
- **Eye discharge/persistent crusty eyelids with red or pink sclera** (whites of eyes) (thick mucus or pus draining from eye, or pink eye).
- **Child is irritable, continuously crying**, or requires more attention than you think we can provide without risking the health and safety of other children in our care.

In addition, your **child must be free of ALL symptoms for 24 hours**. If at anytime before or during the service, one of the volunteers recognizes any of the above symptoms a teacher will contact you and ask you to pick your child up from class/the nursery.

These policies are for the benefit of your child as well as other children. We appreciate your compliance with these procedures as we desire the utmost health and safety of all children attending Victory Kids.
